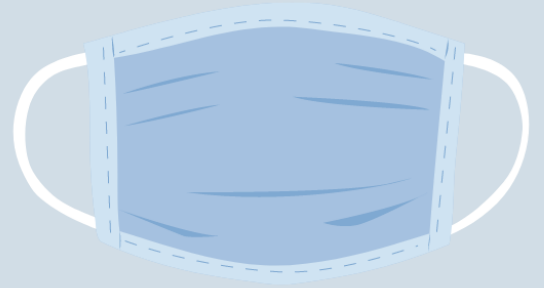

Highland Community College Commencement Ceremony will be May 21, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. in Ben Allen Fieldhouse in Highland, Kansas. Only graduating students will be allowed into the fieldhouse for the commencement ceremony. However, weather permitting, family and friends may gather on the front lawn to watch the processional of graduates as they march to the fieldhouse ten minutes prior to the ceremony. The Commencement will also be live streamed on the jumbo screen located in the Porter Family Stadium for family and friends. Please follow social distance guidelines by wearing a mask and remaining 6 feet apart while viewing the ceremony. After the ceremony, graduates will proceed through the north door of the fieldhouse and greet family and friends in the parking lot south of the Porter Family Stadium for a light reception of cookies and punch.

GRADUATION CHECKLIST
