CONCURRENT

Highland's Concurrent Program provides area Kansas High Schools with the opportunity to expand their curriculum by scheduling HCC courses in conjunction with their normal class offerings. Students have the advantage to taking college courses at high school during the regular school day. Students learn first-hand the demands of the college classroom. The Concurrent Program eases transition from High School to College and provides academic enrichment to students.
