December 13	Last day to submit an overload request form for schedules greater than 18 hours for entire semester, including maximum of 12 hours for 8-week session and 6 hours for 4-week or shorter sessions. See http://highlandcc.edu/pages/request-for-overload for details.
December 13	Last day to request Credit/No Credit grade for Intercession course.
December 13	Final check of prerequisite verification. Students not meeting verification will be dropped.
December 15	Last day to submit new student application for admission for Intercession courses.
December 18	Last day to enroll for Intercession courses.
December 19	Payment or payment arrangement expected for Intercession courses.
December 19	Online Intercession courses begin.
December 19	Last day for 100% refund for Intercession courses.
December 20	Academic Engagement required for Intercession courses. Students must submit coursework in each enrolled course by this date or they will be dropped from the course as a "no show" enrollment. Reenrollment is not available. All issues with MyHCC/Canvas account must be reported to hcconline@highlandcc.edu .
December 20	Last day for 50% refund in Intercession courses.
December 21	Last day to drop Intercession course with no grade reported on transcript.
December 29	Last day for "W" in Intercession courses.
January 10	Intercession courses end at 11:59 pm CST.
January 12	Grades posted for Intercession courses.
