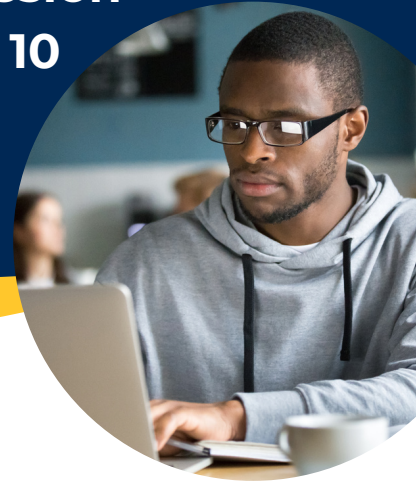

Jan 10-Mar 6	Enrollment available for online second 8-week courses by emailing hcconline@highlandcc.edu from student HCC Email account. Include name, birthday, phone number, and course sections to add. An email confirmation will be sent when processed. Prerequisite verification must be on file prior to enrollment.
February 29	Last day to submit an overload request form for schedules greater than 18 hours for entire semester, including maximum of 12 hours for 8-week session and 6 hours for 4-week or shorter sessions. See http://highlandcc.edu/pages/request-for-overload for details.
February 29	Last day to request Credit/No Credit grade for second 8-week course.
February 29	Final check of prerequisite verification. Students not meeting verification will be dropped.
March 4	Last day to submit new student application for admissions for second 8-week courses.
March 6	Last day to enroll for second 8-week online courses.
March 7	Payment or payment arrangement expected for March online courses.+
March 7	Online second 8-week courses begin.
March 8	Last day for 100% refund for second 8-week courses.
March 19	Academic Engagement required for second 8-week courses. Students must submit coursework in each enrolled course by this date or they will be dropped from the course as a "no show" enrollment. Reenrollment is not available. All issues with MyHCC/Canvas account access must be reported to hcconline@highlandcc.edu .
March 19	Last day for 50% refund in second 8-week courses.
March 24	Last day to drop a second 8-week course with no grade reported on transcript.
March 29-April 1	Easter Break - no coursework due.
April 12	Last day for "W" in second 8-week courses.
May 10	Second 8-week courses end at 11:59 pm CST.
May 13	Grades posted for second 8-week courses.

BOOKS & MATERIALS

BS 101 College Biology

Completion of Fundamentals of Reading/Writing - Advanced (HCC ENG096) and Fundamentals of Math (HCC MAT090) or equivalent placement test scores

BS 203 Microbiology (must meet 1 criteria)

- Completion of College Biology with Lab (HCC BS 101)
- Completion of Physiology with Lab (HCC BS 105)
- Completion of combined Anatomy & Physiology Course (5 credit hour minimum), must include lab credit

BUS204 Microeconomics

Completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) or higher level math course or equivalent placement test scores

ENG101 Composition I (must meet 1 criteria in each category)

Category 1 - Reading Skills

- ACT – Reading Area 16 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – Reading 255 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.25 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.0 or higher + 3.0 or higher in Content area
- Completion of Fundamental Reading/Writing course (HCC ENG096) with a grade of “C” or higher

Category 2 - Writing Skills

- ACT – English Area 18 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – Writing Test 255 and higher
- High School GPA – 3.25 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.0 or higher + 3.0 or higher in Content area
- Completion of Fundamental Reading/Writing course (HCC ENG096) with a grade of “C” or higher

ENG102 Composition II: Literature & Research

Completion of Composition I (HCC ENG101)

MAT103 Intermediate Algebra (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 19-21
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 250-262
- High School GPA – 2.75 or higher + Algebra I with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of Beginning Algebra (HCC MAT100) with a grade of “C” or higher

MAT104 College Algebra (must meet 1 criteria)

- ACT – Mathematics Area 22 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 263 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.00 or higher + Algebra II with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of Intermediate Algebra (HCC MAT103) with a grade of “C” or higher

MAT203 Basic Statistics

- ACT – Mathematics Area 22 or higher
- Accuplacer NextGen – QAS Test 263 or higher
- High School GPA – 3.00 or higher + Algebra II with grade of “B” or higher
- Successful completion of Intermediate Algebra (HCC MAT103) with a grade of “C” or higher
