HCC's Medical Coding Program is designed to prepare students to work in the medical field as a coder in a variety of healthcare settings. Graduates of this program will have the skills and knowledge necessary to use, analyze, and assign the proper codes to diagnoses and medical procedures for the purpose of proper patient care, communication with insurance companies, and billing documentation.

This Associate in Applied Science Degree requires 65 credit hours and is designed to prepare students to take the national Certified Coding Associate (CCA) or Certified Coding Specialist (CCS) exams administered by the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA). The program is available online and can be completed in two years with full-time enrollment. The capstone course, HS 225 Healthcare Coding Practicum, requires clinical hours to be completed in an on-site coding facility; giving students hands-on experience. All other degree coursework can be completed online. HCC requires that computer literacy and technical program degree requirement courses can be no more than 5 years old to count toward this AAS degree.
